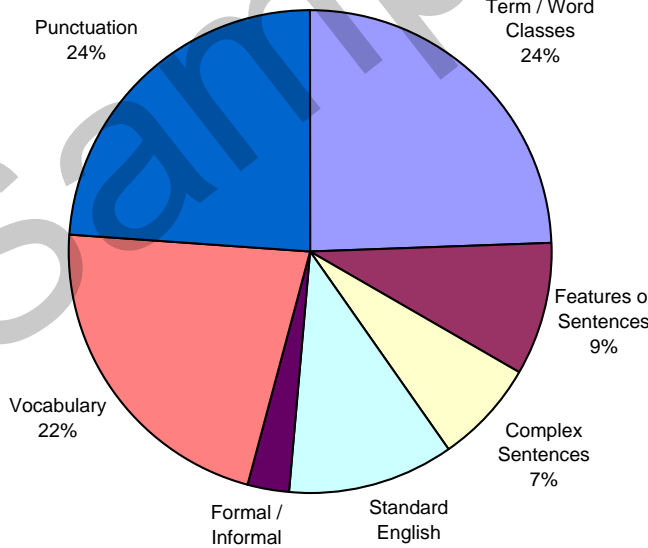

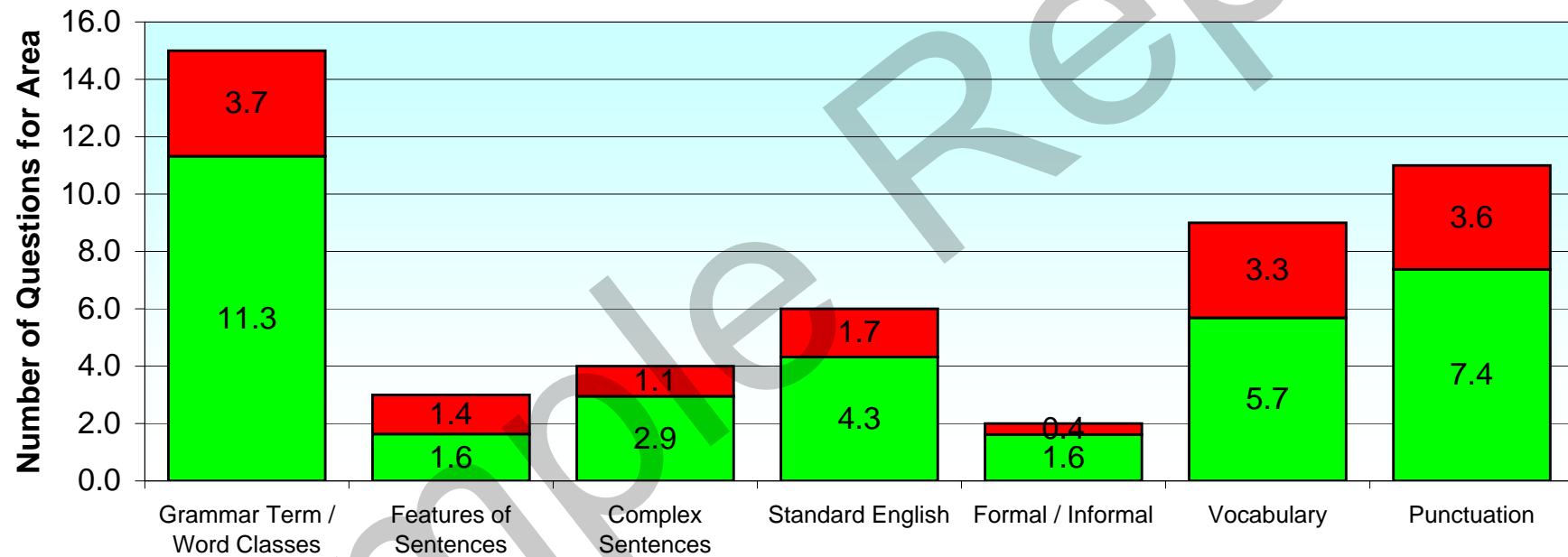

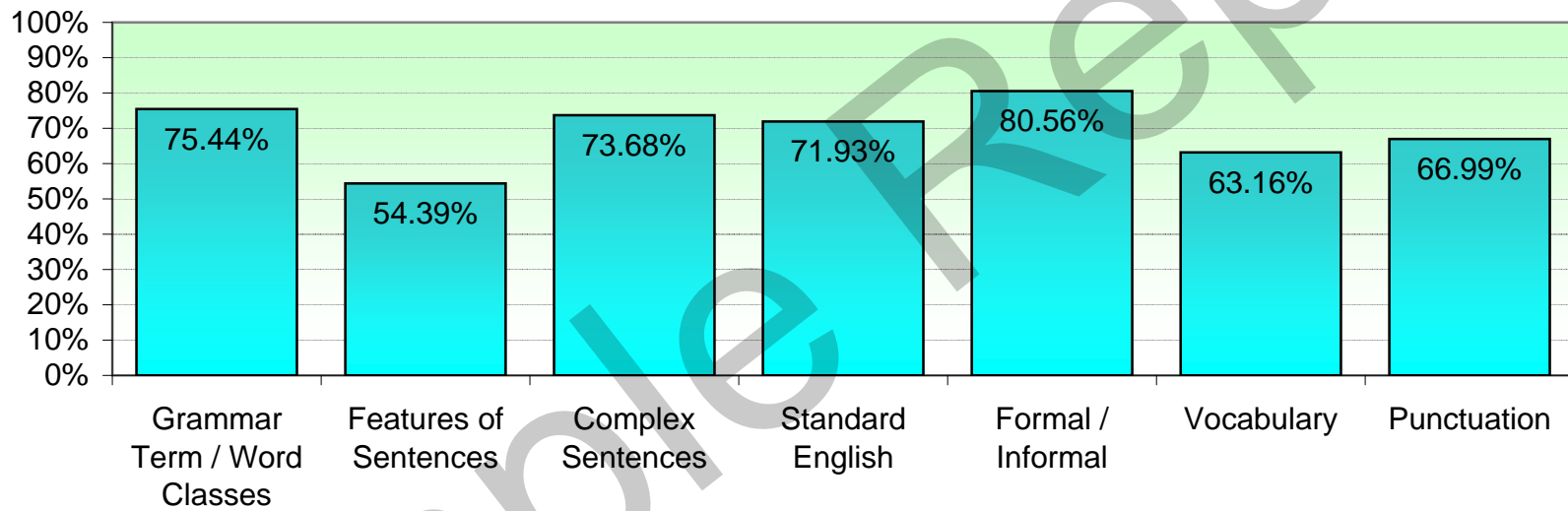

Correct/Incorrect for Cohort



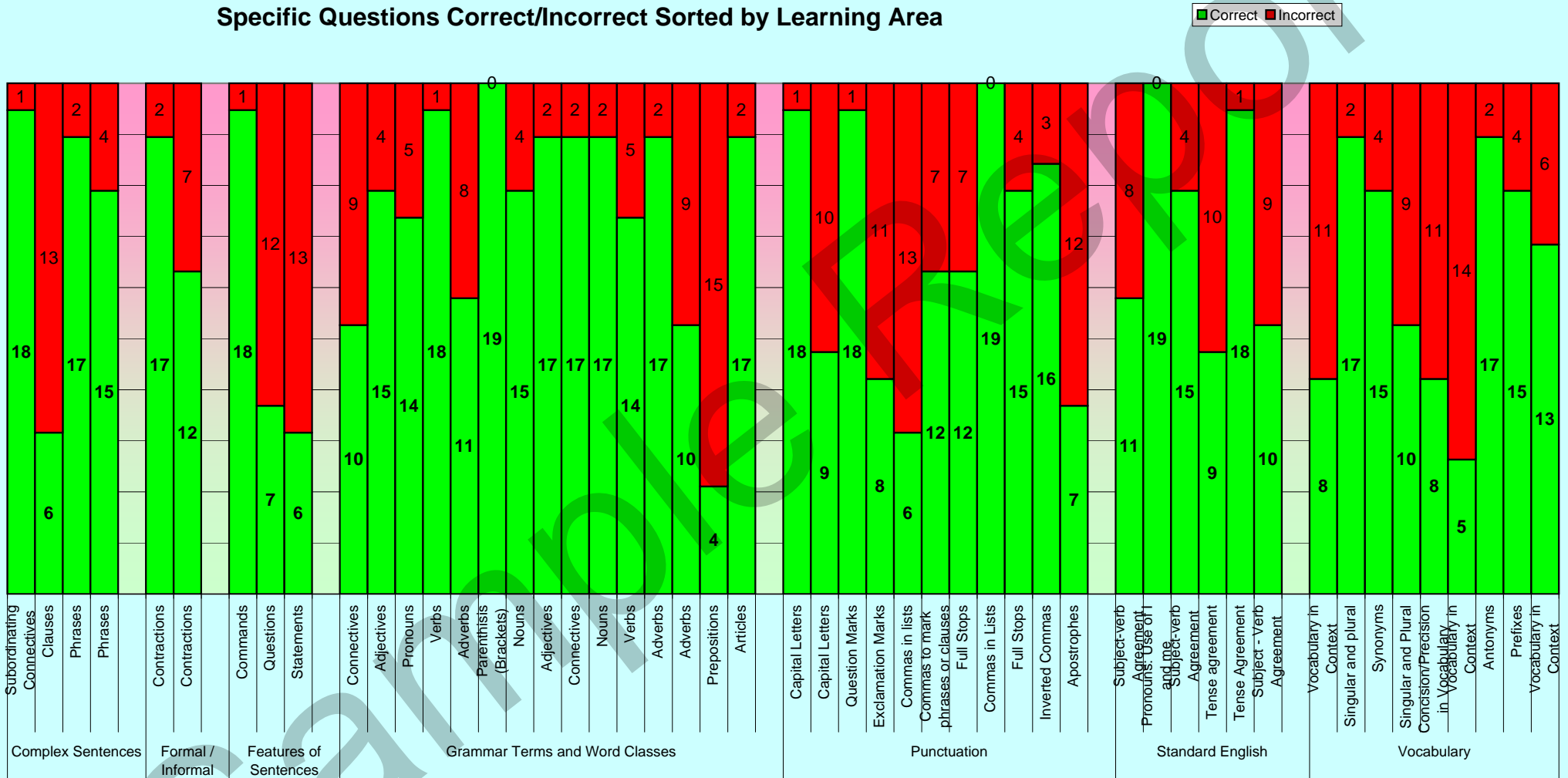
This graph shows the weighting of each area and the average number correct and incorrect answers.
A large area of red would indicate an area of priority.

Cohort Percentage Correct in Each Area



The above graph shows the average percent for the cohort answering the questions in the particular areas correctly. It should be noted that each area does not hold equal weighting.
