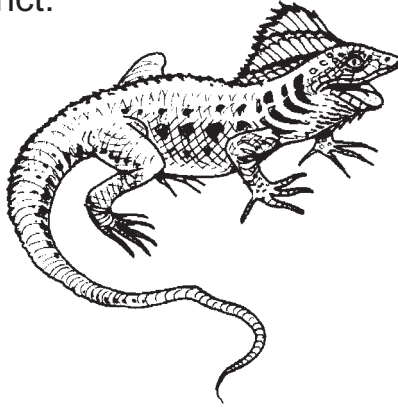

It is an endangered creature, which means that very few remain and it may become extinct.

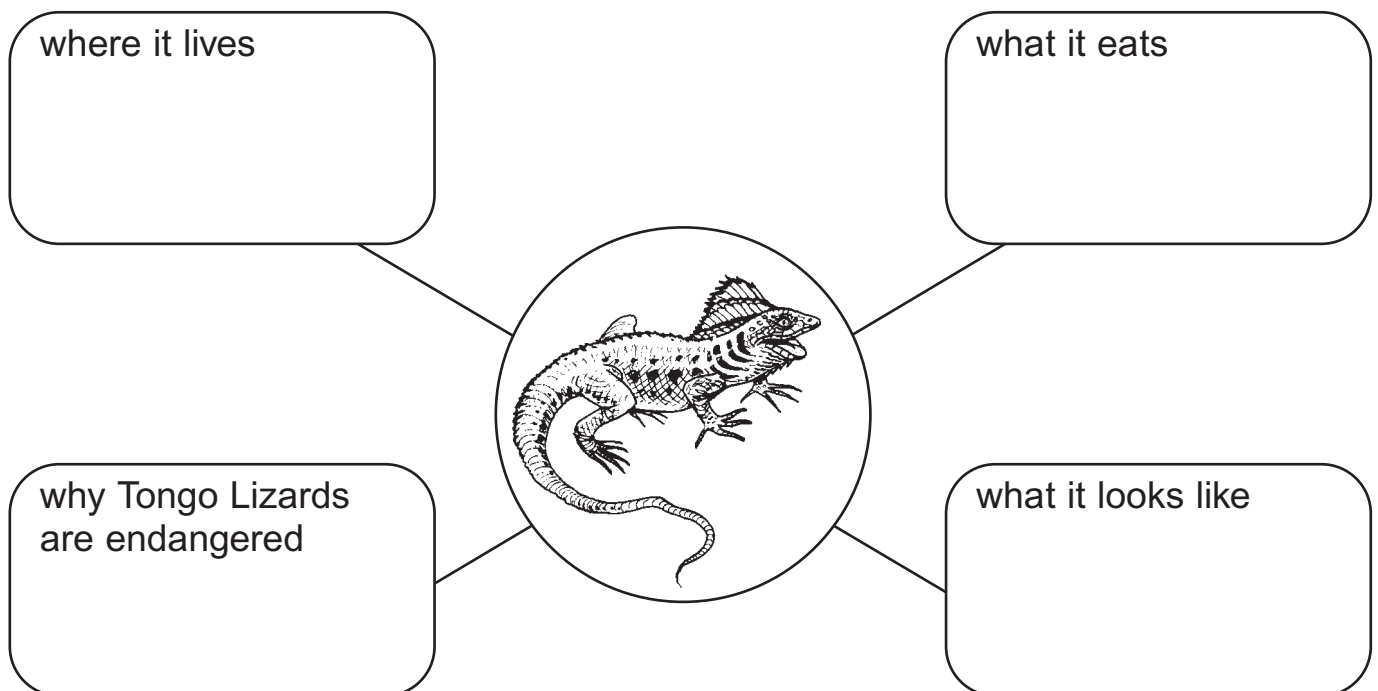


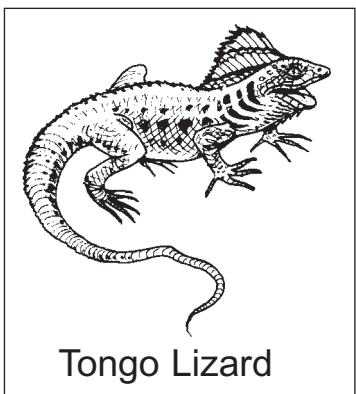
