## Paper 1 Section 1: Little Cousin Clare

### Qu. Answer

- 1 Option 4: He was getting them ready for Clare  
reference to Bryn's (bed)room
- 2 AA: "Your room looks much better now."  
DNA "I'm glad to see you're tidying up, Bryn," said Dad. "Your room looks much better now."  
reference to **both** of the following:
  - animals
  - trucks
 DNA reference to the titles of the books in the illustration
- 4 Option 4: Bryn's mum
- 5 Option 3: He was nervous about meeting Clare  
reference to any of the following acceptable points:
  1. Bryn expecting Clare to be older / bigger / his age
  2. Clare being a baby
  3. Bryn realising he wouldn't be able to play with Clare
 DNA reference to Bryn not having seen her before  
reference to either of the following acceptable points:
  1. Bryn realising Clare was too young / small (to play with them)
  2. Bryn realising that Clare couldn't play with his toys / she would need other toys instead / the toys were unsuitable
- 7 (as she was a baby / too young  
AA reference to Bryn's realisation that he has made a mistake  
DNA reference to Bryn not feeling bad that Clare couldn't play with the toys  
DNA reference to Bryn being tidy
- 8 any reference to a bear
- 9 1 mark for all three boxes correctly ticked:

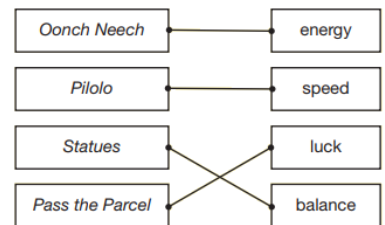
### Qu. Answer

- 10 reference to (tall, waving) wheat  
AA (fat, ripe) grain(s)
- 11 Option 3: flour
- 12 Option 3: trucks  
1 mark for **both** of the following:
  - soft
  - squashy
 AA plausible misspellings
- 14 reference to the shop(s)
- 15 Option 2: autumn
- 16 sweet (fruit)  
AA ripe (fruit)
- 17 reference to the juice factory  
AA (apple) factory  
1 mark for **either** of the following acceptable points
  - spoilt (apples)
  - bad (apples)
- 19 Option 2: squeezes out the juice
- 20 all three boxes numbered correctly:  
In order: 2, 3, (1), 4

## Paper 2 Section 1: Games From Around the World

### Qu. Answer

- 1 Option 3: play many games  
1 mark for any **two** of the following:
  - sticks • stones • coins
- 2 AA (other small) items  
AA: objects  
1 mark for reference to either of the following acceptable points:
  - players having to stay very still / freeze / not move (including references to 'moving' players being eliminated from the game)
- 3 • pretending to be a statue  
AA references to saying 'statue'  
DNA references to helping practise your balance  
DNA references to the party game musical statues
- 4 reference to **both** up and down
- 5a reference to one player hiding the objects / setting up the game  
DNA hiding  
1 mark for reference to either of the following acceptable points:
  - the actions of the player in the middle of the circle / being the (sleeping) kangaroo
  - one player touching the 'kangaroo's' shoulder
 DNA *guessing* without any further explanation
- 6 1 mark for all four lines being joined to the following correct boxes:



Award **1 mark** for **three boxes** correctly ticked and

- 7 award **2 marks** for all **four boxes** correctly ticked

## Paper 2 Section 2: Cobweb Morning

### Qu. Answer

- 8 Option 4: a playground
- 9a 1 mark for reference to any of the following acceptable points:
  - spellings • maths • (silent) reading
 1 mark for reference to any of the following acceptable points:
  - seeing the invisible
  - learning about cobwebs (in the frost)
- 9b • learning about / appreciating spiders  
• learning about nature / the outside  
AA reference to learning to write poetry / create patterns  
DNA references to spellings, maths or (silent) reading
- 10 Option 2: changes how cobwebs look

## Paper 2 Section 3: A New Home

### Qu. Answer

- 11 1 mark for **both** of the following:
  - frogs • insects
- 12 Option 2: They were noisy
- 13 Option 2: It was destroyed.  
1 mark for reference to any of the following acceptable points, up to a **maximum of 2 marks**:
  - the waves being frightening
  - the water being salty
  - there not being any food for the ducks to eat
  - the seagulls were frightening / grumpy / chased them away
- 15 Option 1: to take them to a new home
- 16 1 mark for all four boxes numbered correctly:  
In order: 2, (1), 5, 4, 3
