DNA: reference to JJ not liking the wall without reference to the colour

4 Option 2: The steps were dangerous

- Jasmine wanting to see the top of the picture / shed
- 5 AA: relevant text lifts from the following sentence: *I wanted to see the top of our picture so I climbed the steps*
- 6 Option 1: The steps moved.

- Any of the APs below:
- 7 • the paint splashing
• the paint splashing onto the shed / picture / everywhere

• making a mess
• Jasmine's reaction to the paint spilling
AA: relevant text lifts from the following sentence: *Red, white, green and yellow droplets flicked all over the sky at the top of our lovely painting*

- 10 • Mum being angry or upset with or without an explanation of her reaction
• Mum being shocked / surprised
AA: reference to Mum feeling amazed

11 Option 4: the splashes of paint

Paper 1 Section 2: What Is A Cowboy?

Qu. Answer

- Both of the APs below:
- 12 • a Stetson / hat
• a bandana / scarf
AA: reference to the brim of the Stetson / hat

13 A lasso / rope

14 (a huge area of) grass

Either of the APs below:

- 15 • moving cows / cattle
• looking after or keeping cows / cattle

- Any of the acceptable points below:
- 16 • the length of time the cowboys spent together
• cowboys living and / or working together
• the length of time it took to move the cattle / cows

- Any of the acceptable points below:
- 17 • the amount / weight of things that the horses had to carry
• the distance the horses had to cover / the stamina of the horses
• the horses being ridden by / carrying cowboys
DNA: responses which give only one thing the horses carried (this is not enough to indicate the need for strength)
DNA: responses which indicate only that the horses had to carry things (without indicating that the things were heavy or numerous)

- 18 Texas
AA: reference to (North) America.

- Either of the acceptable points below:
- 19 • the ability to ride horses
• being able to look after or catch cows / cattle

Qu. Answer

- 1 Option 1: outside all of the time
- 2 The rose garden / roses
- 3 (very) demanding (job)
- 4 Option 3 and 5: the season; the weather
- 5 Option 4: begin to die away.
- 6 Breaking up the soil

Any of the APs below:

- enjoying the open air / being outside / not sitting at a desk all day
• keeping active / ft / not sitting at a desk all day
• seeing the enjoyment of the visitors
- 7 • being able to spend contemplative / quiet time in the park
• enjoying the team work / camaraderie / chatting to his colleagues
• enjoying watching the plants grow / gardening / caring for the plants
• listening to the birds sing / looking at the plants / trees
DNA: generic responses which are not based on the text

• Dora's lack of space
- 13 • Dora having an untidy / messy house
• Dora wanting to help a good cause
DNA: reference to Dora wanting to sell her things (without further explanation) / make money

Any of the acceptable points below:

- Dora loving her things / her things being precious
• Dora giving her things away
- 14 • Dora missing her things
• Dora feeling sad about parting with her things
• Dora wanting her things back
• Dora thinking her things might be missing her

15 Option 1: bring back everything she had taken to the jumble sale.
